The fiddler crab(蟹) is a living clock. It indicates the tie of day by the colour of its skin which is dark by day and pale by night. The crab's changing colour follows a regular twenty—four hour plan that exactly matches the daily rhythm of the sun.

Does the crab act ally keep time or does its skin simply answer to the sun's rays, changing colour according to the amount of light which strikes it? To find out, biologists kept crabs in a darkroom for two months. Even without daylight the cab's skin colour continue d to change exactly on time.

This characteristic probably developed gradually in answer to the daily rising and setting of the sun, to help protect the crab from sunlight and enemies. After millions of years it has become completely controlled inside the living body of the crab.

The biologists noticed that once each day the colour of the fiddler crab is especially dark and that each day this happens fifty minutes later than on the day before. To be a good teacher, you need some of the gifts of a good actor; you must be able to hold the attention and interest of your audience; you must be a clear speaker, with a good, strong pleasing voice which is fully under your control: and you must be able to act what you are teaching, in order to make its meaning clear.

Watch a good teacher, and you will see that he does not sit still be for c his class: he stands the whole time he is teaching, he walks about, using his arms, hands and fingers to help him in his explanations, and his face to express feelings. Listen to him, and you will hear the loudness, the quality and the musical note of his voice always changing according to what he is talking about

The fact that a good teacher has some of the gifts of a good actor doesn't mean that he will indeed be able to act well on the stage, for there are very important differences between the teachers work and the actors. The actor has to speak words which he has learn t by heart; he has to repeat exactly the same words each time he plays a certain part, even his movements and the ways in which he uses his voice are usually fixed beforehand. What he has to do is to make all these carefully learnt words and actions seem natural on the stage

A good teacher works in quite a different way. His audience takes an active part in his play they ask and answer questions, they obey orders, and if they don't understand something, they say so. The teacher therefore has to meet the needs of his audience, which is his class. He can not lear his part by heart, but must invent it a she goes along.

I have known many teachers who were fine actors in class but were unable to take part in a stage-play because they could not keep strictly to what another had written.

This is only a coincidence. Likewise, some doctors think that people who have bad flossing habits just happen to also have heart problems, and people who have good flossing habits just happen to have a healthy heart.

The theories that flossing your teeth helps to keep your heart healthy might not be true. But every doctor agrees that flossing is a great way to keep your teeth healthy. So even if flossing does not help your heart, it is sure to help your teeth. This is enough of a reason for everyone to floss their teeth regularly".
